Theme of the Day

Jeremiah's prophetic ministry began in 626 BC and ended sometime after 586 BC. He is known as the weeping prophet because he was God's mouthpiece of the impending destruction that King Nebuchadnezzar would bring on Jerusalem, the capital of the Southern Kingdom of Judah, which was attacked and besieged beginning in 605 BC until its fall in 587 BC. Jeremiah stayed in the city, prophesying and calling the kings and people to repentance. Jeremiah 29:1-14 was written to the exiles in Babylon in 597 BC, providing encouragement and the promise of a return from exile. Jeremiah 33:1-16 was written in 587 BC. After Jerusalem was taken, a group of Jews went into exile to Egypt, taking Jeremiah with them, where he later died.
