## *Theme of the Day*

In the late eighth century BC, Assyria was the world power of the ancient Middle East. Led by Sennacherib, their armies went on a blitzkrieg across various lands. Ruling Judah was Hezekiah, a top-notch king. Along with Josiah, he was one of the two Israelite rulers after David who received not a word of criticism from the biblical writer (see 2 Kings 18:1–8). Though he initially caved in to Assyrian pressure, paying them tribute (18:13–16), Hezekiah later refused to bow to their demands. As the story in 2 Kings 18–19 recounts, Sennacherib would pay dearly for his mocking of the true God. Assyrian records echo the biblical account of his demise—slain by his own sons as he knelt praying before a god who could not save (19:37).
