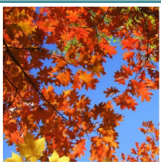
**AS WE GATHER:** Our Bible Reading of the Day is Luke 2:22-40. The presentation of Jesus took place in the temple in Jerusalem. This happened in order to fulfill the Law. (See Leviticus 12:2-4 for the law of purification.) The key figures are Mary and Joseph, who brought the child to the temple, and Simeon and Anna, who met the infant Jesus there. At forty days old, Jesus was dedicated to the Lord God according to Old Testament law. How appropriate this is, because Jesus came from God in the first place to redeem us! His own gift is being offered back to Him.
