AS WE GATHER: Our Bible Reading of the Day is Luke 2:41-52. This passage contains the last of the three scenes in the “infancy narrative” of Jesus in Luke 2: His birth, His presentation at His temple, and His return to His temple. Jesus and His parents, Mary and Joseph, travel “up” to Jerusalem for the Feast of Passover. As pious Jews, Mary and Joseph did this often. But this time, something special happened... Jesus uttered His first recorded words. In doing so, Jesus revealed His true identity and purpose. He is the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world. At Passover, the paschal lamb was slain at the temple. How filled with meaning is this account of the true and final Lamb of God coming to worship at the temple!

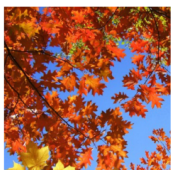
