AS WE GATHER: The Lord rebukes and removes “the shepherds who destroy and scatter the sheep” (Jeremiah 23:1). He gathers the flock, brings them back to the fold, and sets “shepherds over them who will care for them” (Jeremiah 23:3–4). Though you were “separated from Christ” by your sin, “having no hope and without God in the world” (Ephesians 2:12), now “you are fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God” (Ephesians 2:19).

The Behavioral Health Voucher Program offers funding assistance and support for mental health and substance use services for persons impacted by the natural disaster of 2019 and the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic.

What Services Do Vouchers Cover?

- Mental Health Services
- Substance Abuse Services
- Transportation and Medication Cost Assistance

Services can be in-person or via telemedicine. You and your provider determine how many sessions you need.

Do I Qualify for a Voucher?

- Experiencing mental health and/or substance related issues – you qualify.**
- Need funding support to cover costs of services – you qualify.**
- Out of pocket/co-pays on your insurance are beyond your means – you qualify.**
