




"Proverbs: A Guide to Wise Living"

Greetings!



PASTOR GREG'S MESSAGE

RESURRECTION POWER EVERYDAY

God's Word gives us seven power-packed reasons why the Resurrection of Jesus Christ impacts our lives every day of the year...

First, by the Resurrection we are certain that Jesus is the Son of God from Romans 1:4, "and who through the Spirit of holiness was appointed the Son of God in power by His resurrection from the dead: Jesus Christ our Lord."

Second, by the Resurrection we are sure of a right standing before God from Romans 4:25, "He (Jesus) was delivered over to death for our sins and was raised to life for our justification (righteous

standing before God)."

Third, by the Resurrection we claim victory and power for daily living from Galatians 2:20, "I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me."

Fourth, by the Resurrection we have motivation to live a selfless life of service from 2 Corinthians 5:15, "And He (Jesus) died for all, that those who live should no longer live for themselves but for Him who died for them and was raised again."

 \triangle <u>Fifth</u>, by the Resur-

rection we are filled with hope regardless of life's circumstances from 1 Peter 1:3, "Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! In His great mercy He has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead."

Sixth, by the Resurrection we are assured of our bodily resurrection after death from Romans 8:11, "And if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit, who lives in you."

Seventh, by the

Resurrection Jesus guaranteed us eternal life from John 11:25-26, "Jesus said to her, "I am the Resurrection and the Life. The one who believes in Me will live, even though they die; and whoever lives by believing in Me will
