ABOUT THE BOOK

The arsons started on a cold November midnight and didn't stop for months. Night after night, the people of Accomack County waited to see which building would burn down next, regarding each other at first with compassion, and later suspicion.

Vigilante groups sprang up, patrolling the rural Virginia coast with cameras and camouflage.

Volunteer firefighters slept at their stations. The arsonist seemed to target abandoned buildings, but local police were stretched too thin to surveil them all. Accomack was desolate—there were hundreds of abandoned buildings. And by the dozen they were burning.

The culprit and the path that led to these crimes, is a story of twenty-first century America.

Monica Hesse first drove down to the reeling county to cover a hearing for Charlie Smith, a struggling mechanic who upon his capture had promptly pleaded guilty to 67 counts of arson.

But as Charlie's confession unspooled, it got deeper and weirder. He wasn't lighting fires alone; his crimes were galvanized by a surprising love story.


Watch for updates and get energized by how far we as a church family can go!



PASTOR GREG'S MESSAGE

What draws your attention these days? On what kinds of things do your eyes focus? How's your "eye discipline"?

Throughout any given day, we think about hundreds of different matters... people in our lives, things we have to do, things we desire to get, etc. In our daily callings, we inevitably focus on all sorts of good and important matters. But when it comes to what really matters, when it comes to what gives your life security, meaning, and hope, where do you look? What draws your attention?

The devil loves to distract us. He might use a limitless news cycle. He might use an endless supply of easily accessed entertainment. Perhaps he'll use a scrolling social media feed. He'll use your life circumstance, a grumbling stomach, a greedy eye, a perceived slight by another person. Whatever it takes to put you off balance and feel alone.



But God gives you a gift during this Lenten Season of the Church Year... an opportunity to refocus... fixing our eyes on Jesus, the Pioneer and Perfecter of faith. For the joy set before Him He endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

(Hebrews 12:2)

Have you been looking to yourself, eyes turned inward, to find meaning and purpose? Have you been seeking to gain security by grabbing control of circumstances or trying to control other people? Have you been looking for pleasure or love in all the wrong places? If so, it's time to allow the Holy Spirit to turn your gaze in the proper, lifegiving direction ... fixing your eyes on Jesus.
