Our Wednesday series this Lent season is called "Guided to the Cross." Be guided to the cross. Be guided to Jesus. Be guided to forgiveness. Throughout this holy time, we are drawn to Calvary to live in forgiveness, hope, love, peace, trust and perseverance.

Each week, the services in this series reveal how Christ and His cross serve as examples for us of how to live our lives for and through our crucified Lord and Savior.

The schedule is:

<u>Feb 14</u> Ash Wednesday • Guided to Forgiveness (Colossians 1:13-14): When we confess our sins, we find forgiveness in the cross of Christ and are empowered to forgive others..

<u>Feb 21</u> Week 1 • Guided to Hope (2 Corinthians 1:10): When we are uncertain about what the future holds, we discover in the cross the sure hope of heaven.

<u>Feb 28</u> Week 2 • Guided to Love (1 Timothy 1:13-14): When we are separated from others and from God by our sin, the cross brings us together through its love.

<u>Mar 6</u> Week 3 • Guided to Peace (Colossians 1:19-20): With wars waging within and without, the cross settles them all with peace to body, mind and soul.

Mar 13 Week 4 • Guided to Trust (1 Timothy 1:15): Plagued by doubt and competing voices, we turn to the cross to put our trust fully in the salvation won for us there.


What's New in the CHURCH Library??


We have a NEW section of books labeled "LOCAL INTEREST". The books that can be found there are books of either local interest or by local authors.


Many of the books are on a display rack in the Library corner or on the moveable bookshelf.



Greetings!


