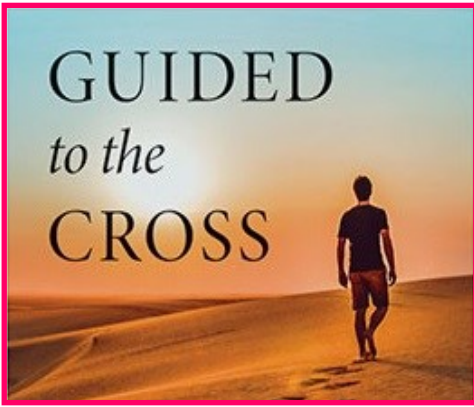

MIDWEEK LENTEN SERVICES

“Guided to the Cross”

Our Wednesday series this Lent season is called “Guided to the Cross.” Be guided to the cross. Be guided to Jesus. Be guided to forgiveness. Throughout this holy time, we are drawn to Calvary to live in forgiveness, hope, love, peace, trust and perseverance.

Each week, the services in this series reveal how Christ and His cross serve as examples for us of how to live our lives for and through our crucified Lord and Savior.

The schedule is:

February 14: Ash Wednesday • Guided to Forgiveness (Colossians 1:13-14): When we confess our sins, we find forgiveness in the cross of Christ and are empowered to forgive others..

February 21: Week 1 • Guided to Hope (2 Corinthians 1:10): When we are uncertain about what the future holds, we discover in the cross the sure hope of heaven.

February 28: Week 2 • Guided to Love (1 Timothy 1:13-14): When we are separated from others and from God by our sin, the cross brings us together through its love.

March 6: Week 3 • Guided to Peace (Colossians 1:19-20): With wars waging within and without, the cross settles them all with peace to body, mind and soul.

March 13: Week 4 • Guided to Trust (1 Timothy 1:15): Plagued by doubt and competing voices, we turn to the cross to put our trust fully in the salvation won for us there.

March 20: Week 5 • Guided to Perseverance (Ephesians 6:18): When we are faced with hardship, we look to Christ on the cross who endured to the end so that we might carry on.

When we practice Lent by holding Jesus Christ at its center, Lent becomes a time of reflection, refreshment and renewal. It’s a time when we take conscious spiritual steps that remind us of the height, depth and breadth of God’s love for us and His purpose for our lives. You have come to salvation in a Savior who never gives up, who never turns away from you and who never will. Let us never give up on Him or on one another in response.
