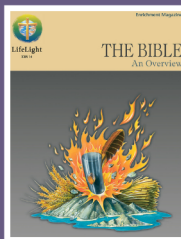

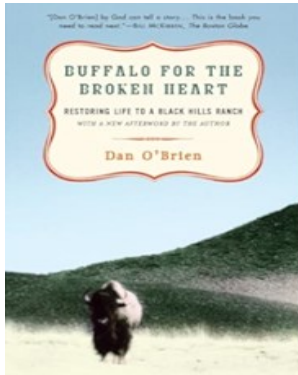

ABOUT THE BOOK

For twenty years Dan O'Brien struggled to make ends meet on his cattle ranch in South Dakota. But when a neighbor invited him to lend a hand at the annual buffalo roundup, O'Brien was inspired to convert his own ranch, the Broken Heart, to buffalo. Starting with thirteen calves, "short-necked,

golden balls of wool," O'Brien embarked on a journey that returned buffalo to his land for the first time in more than a century and a half. Buffalo for the Broken Heart is at once a tender account of the buffaloes' first seasons on the ranch and an engaging lesson in wildlife ecology. Whether he's describing the grazing pattern

of the buffalo, the thrill of watching a falcon home in on its prey, or the comical spectacle of a buffalo bull wallowing in the mud, O'Brien combines a novelist's eye for detail with a naturalist's understanding to create an enriching, entertaining narrative.

So, how did you do with the quiz from last months Clarion? Check your answers.

False 1. There is no such thing as absolute truth. John 17:17 [Jesus said,] “Sanctify them by Your truth. Your word is truth.” Many claim that the views held by conservative Christians are nothing more than their opinions. That would make their views mere opinions as well; meaning that all views are suspect. Someone has to be right. As Christians we trust that the Word of God is true and, as such, is Truth.

False 2. A good person can earn a place in heaven. Ephesians 2:8 “For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God.” Our good works do not earn us a place in heaven. It is by grace through Christ and His work on the cross that give salvation as a gift.

True 3. The Bible is total accurate in all that it teaches. 2 Timothy 3:16 “All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, 17 that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work.” Modern critics have attempted to pick apart Scripture with theories and other manmade ideas. Scripture has stood the test of time because it not of man ... it is from God!

True 4. God is the all-knowing, all powerful, perfect creator of the universe who rules the world today. Exodus 20:10 “In six days the LORD made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that is in them, and rested the seventh day. Therefore the LORD blessed the Sabbath day and hallowed it.” Despite our child-like desire to do everything ourselves, God is in control and in charge of everything.

True 5. You, personally, have a responsibility to tell others your religious belief. Acts 1:8 “But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.” We have been given a wonderful gift meant for all mankind. We ought to share it! How can they know unless they have heard?

False 6. Satan is not a living force but merely a symbol of evil. Mark 1:13 “And He was there in the wilderness forty days, tempted by Satan, and was with the wild beasts; and the angels ministered to Him.” Christ spoke of and taught that the devil is a real and personal being.

False 7. People all pray to the same god, no matter what they call it. Philippians 2:9 “Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.” John 14:6 “Jesus answered, ‘I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.’” Christ is the only way. We do not find the true God through wisdom, human knowledge or any other manmade understanding of the “divine,” but only in and through Jesus Christ as He is revealed in the Bible.

False 8. When people die they become angels. Romans 6:5 “For if we have been united together in the likeness of His death, certainly we also shall be in the likeness of His resurrection.” We die as human beings and God will raise us as human beings. Angels are their own unique creation.

False 9. Sin is an outdated concept. Romans 6:23 “For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.” Death entered into the world through sin. We all die. If death is still relevant for us all, then so is sin. But thanks be to God that He gave us His Son to defeat sin and the grave by His death and resurrection!

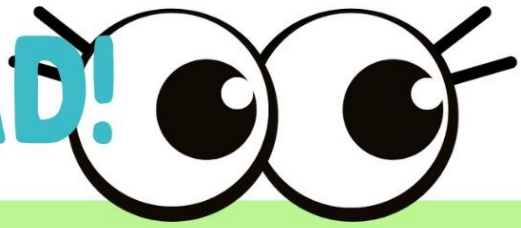

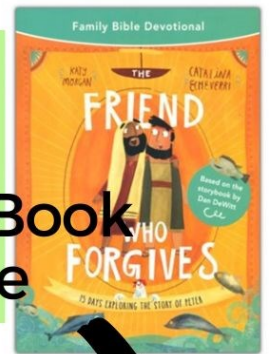

Christ is Risen! He is Risen indeed, Hallelujah!

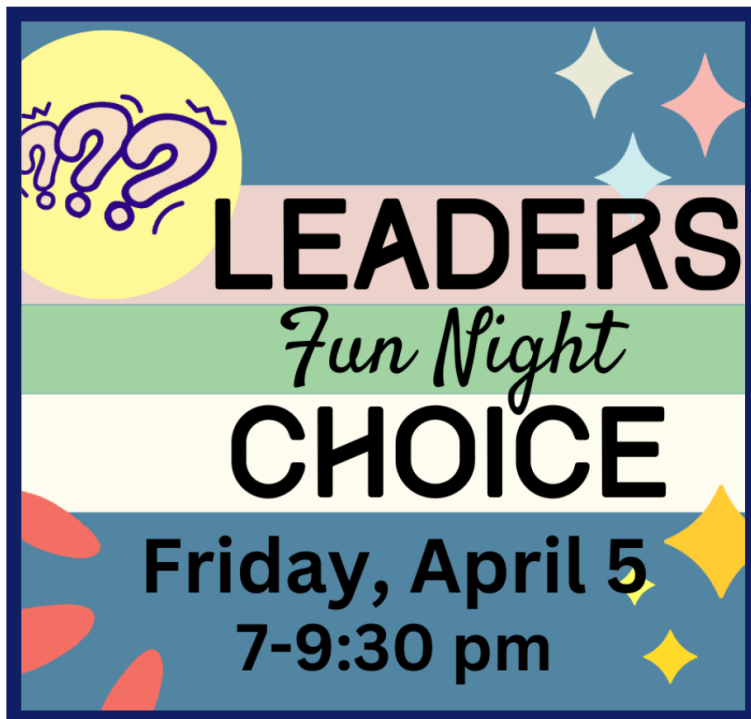
