




## Pastor Greg Lehr and Jacob Shoup



## PASTOR'S CORNER

But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be My witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." After He said this, He was taken up before their very eyes, and a cloud hid Him from their sight. They were looking intently up into the sky as He was going, when suddenly two men dressed in white stood beside them. "Men of Galilee," they said, "why do you stand here looking into the sky? This same Jesus, who has been taken from vou into heaven, will come back in the same way you have seen Him go into heaven." (Acts 1:8-11)

This year on Thursday May 9 is the celebration of Ascension Day. Acts 1:8-11 gives us a snapshoot of Christ's Ascension Day. On Ascension Day we celebrate Christ as He enters His heavenly glory but that's only half the story. He'll return again in glory and when He does He'll take all believers to be with Him forever in heaven.
