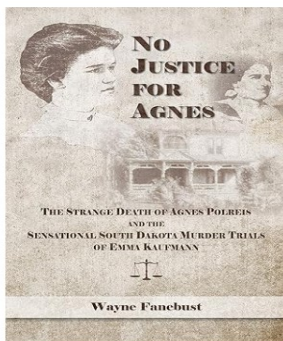

About the Author

WAYNE FANEUBUST has a penchant for writing about the dark side of history and is an ardent advocate for the underdog. He was born in Sioux Falls, practiced law in California and he now lives back in South Dakota.

About the book

For three years, beginning in 1906, the mysterious death of servant girl Agnes Polreis in Sioux Falls followed by the trials of Emma Kaufmann, gripped the nation's attention. Lurid reports of abuse and even torture in the heartland appeared with regularity in newspapers from San

Francisco to Washington, D.C.

"I challenge all the pages of literature to show me so sad a case and so awful a case," roared prosecuting attorney George W. Egan in his closing argument in 1907.

After less than six months in the employ of Emma Kaufmann and her husband, a

wealthy and influential partner in a brewery business in the region's largest city, sixteen-year-old Agnes Polreis, born in Austria-Hungary, was returned to her parents' farm, dead, her emaciated body showing marks of extreme violence 49 wounds in all, some of them gangrenous. An instance of "diabolical cruelty," editorialized one newspaper.

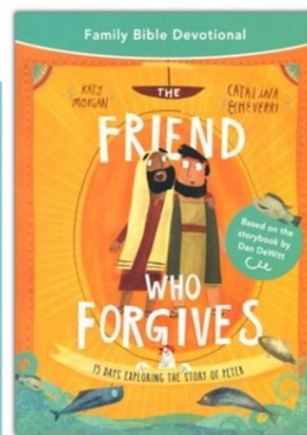
