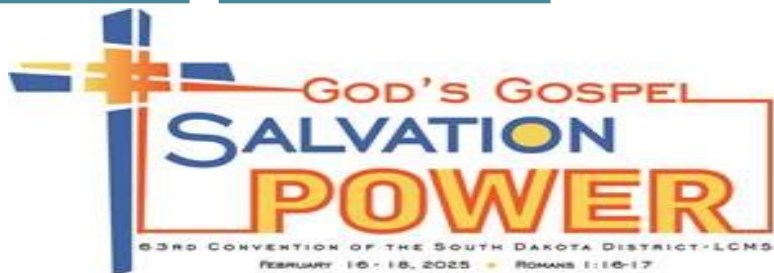
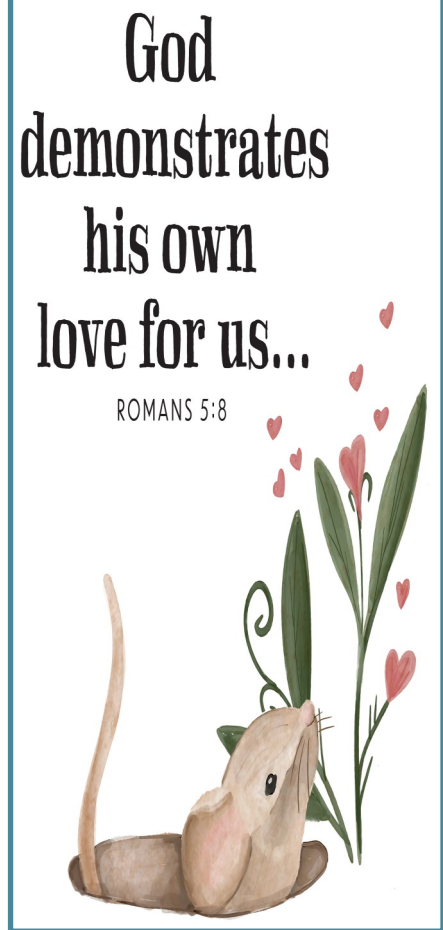
THANK YOU to the Board of Elders and the volunteers who helped get the Christmas decorations down and put away. It's a big job and we appreciate everyone's help to get it done!
