



YOU SEE THEM EVERY SUNDAY but how closely do you really look at Zion's stained glass windows? This summer we will be taking a closer look at the panels. Today we move to the South side of the church and the New Testament.



Window #1—Birth of Christ
Beginning at the front of the south side of the
Sanctuary, we have the works and life of
Christ in symbols. It begins with his birth.
The creche with Chi Rho in the form of a
cross reminds us of the Christ born in a
manger. One can never separate his coming
from the purpose of His coming. The Angels
said, "Your SAVIOR is born, who is Christ
the Lord.

Window #2—Visitors From the East Matthew wrote of visitors from the east wise men who followed the star that they might worship Him, the King of the Jews. Thus we celebrate Epiphany, the Gentile Christmas. The star reminds us that Christ is the Savior of all, Jew and Gentile alike.



Window #3 The Humanity of Jesus Jesus Christ was both God and man. The third window reminds us, however of his humanity and innocence. The flower reminds us that God became flesh and dwelt among us. He was tempted as we are, yet he remained without sin. God's law must be kept and Jesus kept it perfectly in our stead.

Window #4—The Baptism of Jesus Jesus began His ministry with his baptism. The Father, with a voice from heaven, announced this was His beloved Son. The spirit was present in the form of a dove. Jesus had no need for baptism because He was sinless, yet He needed to keep God's law, and thus asked John the Baptist to baptize him in the Jordan River. We see the Baptism shell pouring water over the Christ (Chi Rho) to signify His baptism.
