He gives medicine that heals all sins, including the sin of lacking mercy. He will bear people to a place of refuge, the church, where they can be taken care of and receive more medicine. Then Jesus promises to come back to take all believers to Himself in heaven.



Window #5—Temptation of Jesus

The Spirit led Jesus into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil for 40 days and nights. As Adam was tempted in the garden Christ was also tempted. Where Adam failed and brought death, Christ was victorious over the devil, and we too can claim Christ's power to defeat out enemy, the devil.

Window #6—Teaching About the Law Jesus was a great teacher. In the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus said He came to fulfill the law, not to do away with it. He explained that keeping God's Law

begins in the heart. We see the cross and the scroll to remind us the central truth of scripture is Christ and His death and resurrection for the sins of all.

Window #7—Office of Keys

Jesus called His disciples and gave them the keys to the kingdom. The keys remind us that even today we have the power to forgive or retain sins. In John 20:22-23, "Jesus said to them again, 'Peace be with you. As the Father sent me, so I send you.' Then He breathed on them and said, 'Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive people's sins, they are forgiven; if you do not forgive them, they are not forgiven'."

Window #8—Changing Water to Wine Jesus performed many miracles, the first being the changing of water to wine at the wedding in Cana. Jesus has something better for our homes as He can change our lives. There He revealed His glory and His disciples believed in Him.
