The process for checking out items is simple—we will be glad to show you how.

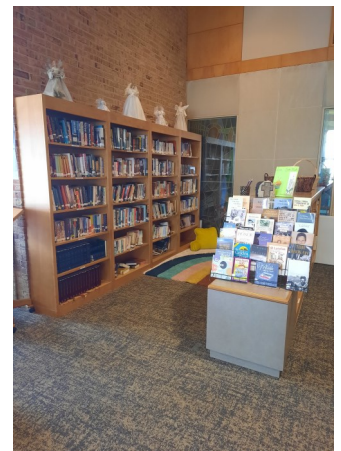
And make plans to attend a Library “Open House” on Sunday, January 18th after both services.

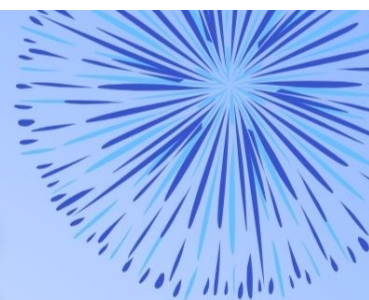

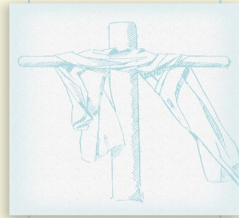
